“AHCCCS Awards Managed Care Contracts”

Arizona Health Care Cost Containment System (AHCCCS) Announces Award of Contracts for its Acute Care Program.

(Phoenix, Arizona) May 13, 2008- AHCCCS has awarded eight managed care organizations contracts to provide acute care services to low-income families with children, pregnant women, children under 18, and disabled people who are enrolled in Arizona's State Medicaid program. Twelve managed care organizations bid to be contractors, seven of which bid for statewide contracts.

Currently, nearly 900,000 Arizona residents are enrolled in the AHCCCS Acute Care program at an annual cost of over \$3.0 billion. An individual must meet the income requirement of 100% of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) to qualify for AHCCCS acute care benefits, which currently equals \$867 per month per individual or \$1767 per month for a family of four. AHCCCS members are covered for medical care, including doctor's office visits, hospitalization, prescriptions, lab work, and behavioral health services. AHCCCS is viewed as a national model for its success in managing a high quality, cost effective Managed Care Medicaid System.

“I was pleased with the number and quality of the managed care companies that submitted proposals to serve AHCCCS members as acute care health plans,” says Anthony Rodgers, Director of AHCCCS. “This is additional proof of the outstanding reputation of Arizona’s acute care program.”

Proposals were evaluated based on organizational capability and experience, provider network capacity and management, program services and quality management, and cost to deliver care. Contracts are awarded for five years beginning October 1, 2008.
