

Georgia Medicaid Vision Benefits Program Options

Please review the following options for dispensing materials to enrollees of Georgia Medicaid carefully. Identify which option will work best for your practice and return the signed document to Avesis by fax (866.874.6834), mail or email (GeorgiaMedicaid@Avesis.com):

- Georgia Correction Industries – GCI**
Provider will be provided a consignment frame kit from Georgia Department of Corrections (GCI) and place all eyeglass orders with GCI. The provider will receive a \$15.00 dispensing fee for the initial order when properly billed to Avesis.

- Essilor Contracted Lab**
Provider Practice will receive at no cost a “covered frame” kit on consignment from Essilor. The provider will place all eyeglass orders directly with Essilor’s assigned laboratory. The provider will be reimbursed a \$15.00 dispensing fee for the initial order when properly billed to Avesis.

Out of frame kit selection -

Should the member elect to purchase from the providers own inventory, in addition to securing the member signature on an “Acknowledgement of Financial Responsibility” form, the provider will place the order with a lab of their own choosing (GCI and Essilor may also fulfill the order) and submit to Avesis utilizing the following CPT codes: V2025, V2199, V2299 and V2399. The provider will be reimbursed \$10.00 for noncovered frames and \$10.00 for non-covered lenses and will reduce the amount of the member’s financial responsibility by \$20.00 for non covered frames and \$20.00 for non-covered lenses.
